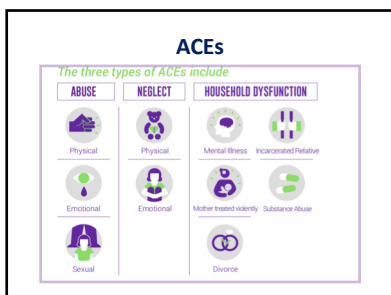


### Saint Mary's SARC Research on Child Sexual Exploitation

- **Young person's advocate**  
Caseload data collected
- **Inclusion criteria:**  
CSE case (or considered high risk)  
Greater Manchester case  
Attended for FME at St Mary's SARC  
ISVA follow-up at St Mary's SARC  
Over 4 calendar years (2013 – 2016)
- **216 cases** met criteria

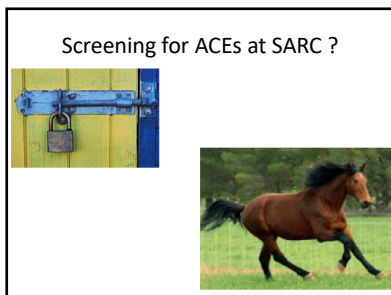

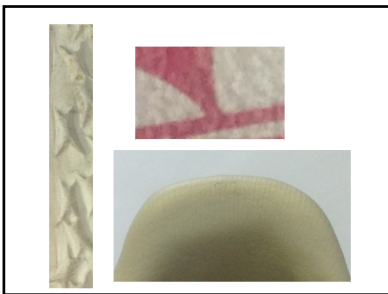
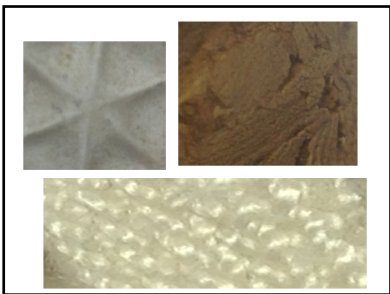
